WE LOVE BUHI PROFILE

Mission: We Love BuHi is a 501(c)3 nonprofit preserving the multicultural identity of Atlanta's Buford Highway.

2020 was a year that most of us will unlikely forget. For families and businesses of the Buford Highway Corridor, the year brought stress, struggle, and strife. Many loss their jobs, their homes, their businesses, or worst, someone they loved. But above all that we experienced as local neighborhoods, communities, districts, state, and country, COVID-19 raised light on the importance of advocacy, ally-ships, and awareness.

In our agency's inaugural annual report, we share with stakeholders activities that turned our work from a grassroots organization into a trusted contender within the NGO space of making resounding impacts for immigrant communities of the Buford Highway Corridor.



A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It's mind-boggling to think that a year ago, We Love BuHi was putting the finishing touches to preparing for our attendance of the much anticipated, Lunar Festival (Chinese New Year Celebration) at Atlanta's Chinatown. It was also where and when I first noticed the impacts of what xenophobic narratives from a global pandemic could do to our local communities. The damage has been nothing short of crippling, our resiliency as immigrants put to the fire in ways that tested our unity, our grit, and our survival. But through it all, we have and will continue to achieve what we've always been sought out to do; and that is to raise families, make a living, and rely on one another for comfort and support. I dedicate my work over the course of this intensely emotional year to the people and communities of the Buford Highway Corridor and in memory of my late father, Dr. George Y. An, who lost his battle with COVID-19 on August 10, 2020. As a resident and entrepreneur of the Highway, my dad wrote a sonnet of sorts for me as I was on-boarding back in 2019. I hope it resonates to you as much as it continues to speak to me about a place we love and know as Buford Highway.
